Let these branches be signs of his victory, and grant that we who carry them may follow him in the way of the cross, that, dying and rising with him, we may enter into your kingdom; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, now and forever. Christ's journey to the cross is filled with images that serve as vivid reminders of His sacrificial love for us. These images are the centerpiece of Come to the Cross and Remember.

This day is a day of stark contrasts. What began with lauds and laughter, and a triumphal procession into Jerusalem, ends a short week later with sneers and jeers at the cross of Golgotha. Resist the urge to move quickly from today, Palm Sunday, to next Sunday, Easter Sunday – from celebration to celebration. Rather, meditate throughout this week, as with this cantata, on the journey of Jesus to the cross, to death and the grave, and the victory won for us in his death and resurrection.
